
REMINDER - GENERAL ASSEMBLY: SEPTEMBER 21ST

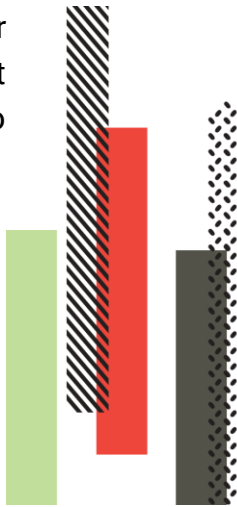
