PRAM-COMMERCE ON ST-LAURENT BOULEVARD!

The SDBSL is proud to announce that it has been designated to benefit from the City of Montreal's program, "PRAM-Commerce" for the year 2019.

Pram-Commerce is a twoyear program designed to

stimulate, revitalize or consolidate Montreal's commercial streets, PRAM-Commerce is the ideal development tool for the Boulevard Saint-Laurent merchants and property owners. It provides financial assistance to renovate the facades of commercial buildings and modernize the interior and exterior of businesses. The city of Montreal will subsidize up to one-third of the cost of eligible work for the duration of the program.

The program will **not commence until the summer 2019 and only businesses who offer products and/or services to the general public are admissible (B2C)**, also note any work undertaken before the official implementation date will not be eligible for the grant. This is however a great time to start thinking about any renovations you would like to plan once the program has officially come into effect.
