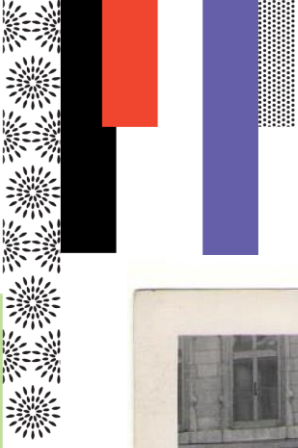




SEPTEMBER STREET CLOSURE - BLVD

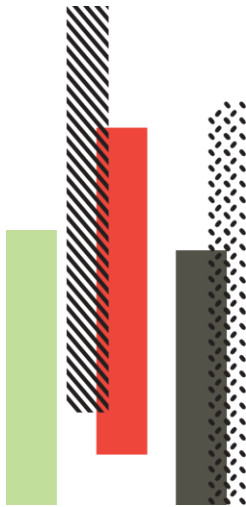
