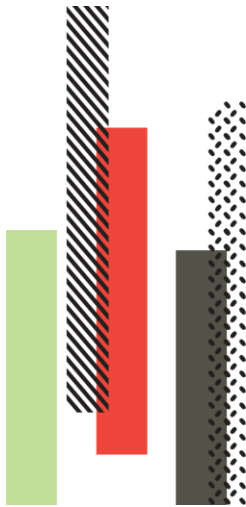

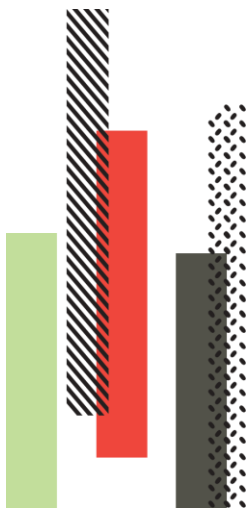
## **By-law regarding commercial signs**

The Office québécois de la langue française announced changes regarding the by-law concerning commercial signs, in relation with the Charte de la langue Française. These modifications aim to regulate the display of commercial trademark while guaranteeing the **predominant** presence of French in the sphere of linguistic displays in Quebec. You have until November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to carry out adequate modifications on your exterior commercial sign to comply with the by-law. Do not forget that the Saint-Laurent boulevard has recently been admitted to the PRAM-Commerce program. This subsidy program could be beneficial for purposes of accompanying you in your works. 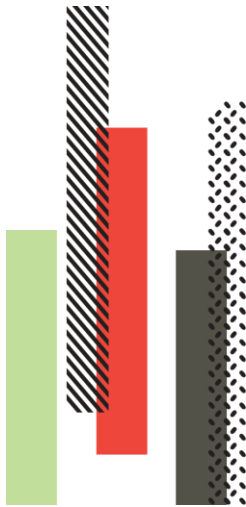
