



MURAL FESTIVAL 2016

The 4th edition of the MURAL Festival is just around the corner! For a second consecutive year, the boulevard will be closed to traffic, between Sherbrooke and Mont-Royal, for **11 straight days** (from **June 9th to the 19th**). To consult the program, visit the <u>MURAL website</u>.
